

In the DeVaux Residence there were two bathrooms added, a master bathroom and a Guest bathroom on the second floor of this home.

The Master Bathroom contains a vanity with two sinks and a linen cabinet, a walk-in shower, and a water closet. The vanity is lit by four pendants hung from above, lighting the counter top. Each sink vessel is set up on its own pedestal and the common storage area between is set lower with two drawers. The linen cabinetry is done in the same style as the vanity cabinetry. The water closet is screened behind a half wall and an original window sash saved from the renovation of the original home. The slate tile shower has built in niches into the walls and the oil-rubbed bronze shower faucet matches the vanity faucets as well.

The guest bathroom is finished in a more simple manner. The homeowners choose a pebble pattern tile that is used as a backsplash, mirror surround and a detail with in the shower. The tub/shower also contains a couple of tile shelves that match the tile in the shower.
