

This 1900s home underwent a full exterior renovation with the addition of a new master suite located in the rear of the home. The Master Bedroom suite contains a large bedroom, full bathroom, walk-in closet and a porch overlooking the large backyard. Below the new second story addition, the first floor addition contains a rear porch, mud room, and a new laundry room.

The exterior of the home was stripped of all of the wood siding and a new infiltration barrier was installed. Per the homeowners' request, a new high end vinyl siding product was used to minimize the amount of maintenance that would be required in the years to come. The existing roof was straightened, restructured and new shingles were installed. All of the existing windows were replaced with new wood windows with vinyl exteriors to complete this complex renovation.
